

ELECTION PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Title 68, Oklahoma Statutes 2001, as amended, Section 2701-2706, inclusive and pursuant to Resolution No. 843 of the City Council of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma authorizing the calling of an election for the purposes hereinafter set forth, I, the undersigned, Seth Adams, Mayor of the City of Clinton, Custer County, Oklahoma, hereby call a special election to be held on the 7th of April, 2015, within said City of Clinton, Oklahoma, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City of Clinton, Oklahoma, for their approval or rejection of the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

SHALL A PROPOSITION OF THE CITY OF CLINTON, OKLAHOMA, ENTITLED:

A PROPOSITION PROVIDING THAT A PORTION OF 3-2-7 OF THE CITY OF CLINTON SALES TAX CODE CONTINUE THE LEVY OF NINETY-FIVE HUNDREDTHS PERCENT (0.95%) SALES TAX ON THE GROSS RECEIPTS OF CERTAIN SALES; PROVIDING THAT THE PURPOSE OF SUCH SALES TAX SHALL BE SOLELY FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES: EIGHTY-FIVE PERCENT (85%) OF THE PROCEEDS SHALL BE APPLIED TO THE CONTINUED DEBT SERVICE OF THE UTILITY SYSTEM AND SALES TAX REVENUE BONDS SERIES 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING A WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND ASSORTED FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE AND FIFTEEN PERCENT (15%) SHALL BE PAID INTO THE CITY'S ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND; UNLESS THE BOND ISSUE PAYS OFF PRIOR TO TERMINATION OF THIS SALES TAX, AT WHICH TIME PROCEEDS SHALL BE ALLOCATED 25% TO REPAIR, MAINTENANCE AND REFURBISHMENT OF THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT AND 75% TO THE GENERAL FUND; PROVIDING SAID SALES TAX SHALL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2044, FIXING EFFECTIVE DATE; MAKING PROVISIONS CUMULATIVE; AND PROVIDING SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS;

BE APPROVED?

The ballot used at said election shall set out the proposition as above set forth, and shall also contain the words: TO VOTE, COMPLETE THE ARROW POINTING TO YOUR CHOICE, LIKE THIS

FOR THE PROPOSITION – YES
AGAINST THE PROPOSITION – NO

If the voter desires to vote for the above proposition, he shall complete the arrow point to the choice "YES FOR THE PROPOSITION". If he desires to vote against the above proposition, he shall complete the arrow pointing to the choice "NO AGAINST THE PROPOSITION".

The polls shall be opened at 7:00 a.m. and remain open continuously and be closed at 7:00 p.m. on the day of the election.

The number and location of the polling places for said election shall be the same as the regular precinct polling places designated by the Custer County Election Board, which officers shall also act as counters.

Returns of said election will be canvassed by the County Election Board of Custer County and results will be certified by said Custer County Election Board to the City of Clinton through the City Clerk.
