Dear Lisa:

Western Plains Library System (WPLS) has a goal of updating the interior of the Clinton Public Library over the next year. In conjunction with the Friends of the Clinton Public Library, WPLS will be updating furnishings and adding additional technology. The largest project in the plan is new carpeting for the library. The existing carpet was installed in 1992 as part of a library-wide construction project. This carpet has performed well but is beginning to show wear after 22 years.

Western Plains Library System is requesting funds in the amount of \$15,000 from the City of Clinton that will be used to re-carpet the library. The re-carpeting project has been estimated to cost \$30,000. Per this estimate, Western Plains has included in its 2015 Fiscal Year budget \$15,000. We are hoping that the City of Clinton will furnish the other half. Western Plains will bid the project and bear any additional costs above the estimate for the carpeting.

This project is an excellent opportunity for WPLS and the City to work together to improve a City-owned asset which contributes greatly to the quality of life in Clinton.
