Fire Chief Randy Carpenter presented a recommendation to accept the bid from Brindlee Mountain for a 1999 Pierce, Dash in the amount of \$349,000.00. He explained that the truck has a 100 foot ladder rather than an 85 foot, it has much less mileage, the original paint is red and will not need to be repainted. He also reported that Pierce has just opened a new service center in west Oklahoma City which would be more convenient than Rogersville, MO.

Motion was made by Councilman Rodolph and seconded by Councilman Lowry to follow the recommendation of Fire Chief Randy Carpenter to purchase the 1999 Pierce from Brindlee Mountain for \$349,000.00.
