



**TASK ORDER FOR
ENGINEER-OWNER AGREEMENT
(Doc. No. AE-2 Exhibit A)**

This Task Order is entered into and authorized by Owner this _____ day of _____, 2015, by and between City of Clinton, Oklahoma (hereinafter called OWNER) and Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc. (hereinafter called ENGINEER).

The parties agree that the ENGINEER shall perform the following Services in accordance with the terms of the Engineer-Owner Agreement dated June 2, 2014:

1. Scope of Services:

Provide hydrogeologic investigation and engineering services associated with the Alternate Well Site, Alternate Pipeline, and Additional Well Site Investigations.

Scope of Services shall be as follows:

1. Generate a summary report of investigation activities completed to date.
2. Complete short-term pumping tests on up to three (3) existing wells:
 - 2.1. Wells will be identified by Owner or others as being potential water supply sources,
 - 2.2. Analyze pump test data.
 - 2.3. Generate a technical memorandum of test results.
3. Additional geophysics investigation:
 - 3.1. Assist the Owner with contracting a geophysical subcontractor to survey areas of interest.
 - 3.2. Coordinate with subcontractor contracted by Owner, provide geologic data and direction, and assist with access.
 - 3.3. Review geophysical data and report to identify locations for test drilling.
4. Complete one (1) test drilling program at selected site:
 - 4.1. Assist the Owner with contracting a drilling subcontractor.
 - 4.2. Coordinate and supervise drilling contractor to drill four (4) test borings.
 - 4.3. Coordinate contractor during short duration (approximately 5 hour) pump tests at each of the four (4) test boring locations.
 - 4.4. Assist with collection of water quality samples.
 - 4.5. Evaluate geologic data and analyze pump test data.
 - 4.6. Generate technical memorandum of investigation results.
5. Program Management:
 - 5.1. Coordinate project activities.

2. Compensation:

The basis of compensation for the above Services shall be Hourly Rate per ENGINEER's Rate Sheet, attached hereto, subject to a Not-to-Exceed cap of \$170,280, without further authorization.

3. Other Terms:

- A. The terms of this Task Order supersede any contrary terms of the Engineer-Owner Agreement.

B. ENGINEER will proceed with providing the services set forth herein immediately upon Task Order execution.

NOTES:

1. Position classifications listed above refer to the firm's internal classification system for employee compensation. For example, "Associate", "Senior", etc., refer to such positions as "Associate Engineer", "Senior Architect", etc.
2. For any nonexempt personnel in positions marked with an asterisk (*), overtime will be billed at 1.5 times the hourly labor billing rates shown.
3. Project time spent by corporate officers will be billed at Level 17 rate plus 25 percent.
4. For outside expenses incurred by Burns & McDonnell, such as authorized travel and subsistence, and for services rendered by others such as subcontractors, the client shall pay the cost to Burns & McDonnell plus 5%.
5. Monthly invoices will be submitted for payment covering services and expenses during the preceding month. Invoices are due upon receipt. A late payment charge of 1.5% per month will be added to all amounts not paid within 30 days of the invoice date.
6. The services of contract/agency personnel shall be billed to Owner according to the rate sheet as if such contract/agency personnel is a direct employee of Burns & McDonnell.
7. The rates shown above are effective for services through December 31, 2014, and are subject to revision thereafter.
